Family Violence is a problem that permeates our businesses, schools and homes. Triangle United Way helps families affected by violence and provides hope for the often interrelated problems of child abuse, child neglect, and domestic violence. The Families Community Care Team of Wake County is made up of agencies, experts and community volunteers who collaborate to strengthen families. This group supports programs that work together to provide Wake County families with healthy, safe and emotionally stable environments:

CONSUMER CREDIT COUNSELING helps victims become financially independent through budgeting, debt reduction, and financial counseling. Triangle Family Services (919) 821.1770 (Spanish-speaking services available)

CRIANZA CON CARIÑO provides parent education and support services to rural, Spanish-speaking families to prevent child abuse. (Crianza Con Cariño is a collaboration between Catholic Social Ministries, a United Way agency, and SAFEchild.) DOSE (Domestic Offenders Sentenced to Education) is a yearlong education program for perpetrators of domestic violence that promotes the safety and well-being of victims and their children. Triangle Family Services (919) 821.0790 (Spanish-speaking services available)

FAMILY SERVICES PROGRAMS for grandparents, single dads and other family caregivers provide support and resources on domestic violence and other family issues. Raleigh Nursery School (919) 834.0707

HISPANIC FAMILY CENTER (Centro para Familias Hispanas) offers crisis counseling and on-going mental health counseling to Hispanic/Latina women and children affected by domestic violence. Catholic Social Ministries (919) 832.0225 (Spanish-speaking services available)

HOMESTEADERS assists families with youth, ages 7-21, during times of crisis by providing support, training, and resources in order to maintain and strengthen the family. Haven House (919) 833.3312

HOPELINE provides 24-hour, anonymous and confidential telephone support to individuals affected by family violence, suicide, depression, etc. HopeLine (919) 231.4525

INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY COUNSELING provides mental health and psychiatric services for victims of domestic violence and survivors of childhood sexual or physical abuse. Triangle Family Services (919) 821.0790 (Spanish-speaking services available)

INTERACT provides free, round-the-clock counseling, shelter, and prevention programs for adults and children affected by domestic violence, dating violence, and sexual assault. Interact (919) 828.8320 (Spanish-speaking services available)

LEGAL SERVICES assists, free of charge, in getting restraining orders on behalf of victims of domestic violence and helping with related issues, such as custody and child support. Legal Aid of North Carolina, Inc. (919) 828.4647
